Please find below the next batch of work for the coming week, just two days! We can park Spellbound and Maths Time for this week as there will be time to continue these from next week. Please continue with the daily work of PM Readers and Just Handwriting. The PM publishers gave 30 days free access to their books and I suggested using them from May 11<sup>th</sup>. The 30 days runs until June 10<sup>th</sup> so I'll leave it to yourselves to decide if you want to catch up on the days of no schoolwork.

### Daily Tasks

**Reading:** Please continue with one new book a day and also look back on the book from the day before too from the PM Readers.

**Just Handwriting:** One page per day.

### Work for the week

**Word Wise:** Unit 16 Page 62-65.

**Planet Maths:** 3D Shapes Pages 121-124. The children seem to enjoy this topic and get through the work quickly so 2 pages per day should be fine. They love examining/discovering the features of 3D shapes they can find at home. Cereal boxes, dice from board games, tinned food cans and footballs/tennis balls or similar can be used to count the faces/edges/corners.

**Bua na Cainte:** I'm just going to leave the same advice for Irish. I understand it may be the hardest subject to feel that you are making progress with but as outlined it's about keeping their ear into it. I hope the file is working for you.

If it is working, focus on the An Teilifis topic. Ceacht 1 and Ceacht 4 will help with pages 67+68. For Page 68 the children can try to read the sentences after listening to Ceacht 4. They could also play a little game where one person makes the animal noise and the child says what they heard- Chuala mé \_\_\_\_\_.

**Window on the World:** Rubber and Plastic Pages 80+81.

**Grow in Love:** Pentecost Pages 46+47. We can skip over the Easter section in case they want more Easter eggs!

I repeat again what I said about each household doing what suits you and your circumstances the best. Some may have parts of the work completed already and that's fine. As said before, use your judgement to decide on the amount to complete either way to suit your circumstances.
