Please note the information below is subject to change...

-  School hours are as normal 8.50a.m. - 1.30p.m. for Infants and 8.50a.m. - 2.30p.m. for 1st - 6th classes.
- Morning drop off window 8.50a.m. - 9.05a.m. Different entry points for classes, see below.
- Pick up between 1.20p.m. - 1.30p.m. for Infant classes.
- Pick up 2.20p.m. 1st & 2nd classes
- Pick up 2.30p.m. 3rd - 6th classes.
-  There will be no access to the school building for parents or visitors.
- All staff will complete COVID induction training.
-  Each class will have their own outdoor zone for break time as usual.
-  As per current guidelines, all staff will wear face coverings where a distance of 2m cannot be observed.
-  Everyone will use hand sanitiser upon entering the building and again after each break.
-  Pupils and staff will wash their hands regularly and will be reminded of technique.
- As per DES guidelines, the school will provide sanitiser and children are not permitted to bring bottles of sanitiser with them to school.
- Classrooms will be cleaned daily with toy/resource sharing kept to a minimum and cleaned as per guidelines.
-  Pupils must be kept home with **high temperature, cough, breathing difficulties or loss of taste or smell.** Pupils should also be kept home if generally unwell.
- Pupils should stay home for 14 days after returning from a country not on the green list.
-  If showing symptoms, pupil will be isolated and parents called. Parents will contact GP.
- HSE Contact Tracing will inform parents and school if a case is confirmed.
- Physical distancing from Junior Infants - 2nd class is not a Department of Education recommendation, 3rd-6th will be in Pods in their classes with 1m between the pods.
-  We ask pupils to leave their pencil case in school. Each home will need stationery for homework.
