Support

- 2. For children in the younger classes, or children with SEN, we are happy for parents to walk their child to within 2m of their class entry point, as long as social distancing is observed. This will be reviewed if social distancing is not upheld.
- 3. As parking is limited we expect most children to leave their cars independently, safely walk to their entry door, sanitise their hands and

4. At pick up, we ask that once you have your child, you go to your car and exit the school grounds immediately. We have to uphold all government guidelines regarding Covid-19 on the school campus.
